

Final Bridge Span Placements Scheduled

**SW Macadam Avenue, I-5 Northbound on-ramp will be closed
January 10, 11, and 12 from 8:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.**

Workers are preparing to place the final bridge spans across SW Macadam Avenue and connect to the bridge's elevator tower. Roadway closures and detours are planned as part of this work.

On Monday (January 9) a large crane will be set up next to SW Macadam Avenue near the Tram tower, **closing the sidewalk on SW Macadam Avenue** that connects SW Curry Street to SW Kelly Avenue. The sidewalk closure will be in effect **Monday, January 9 at 8:00 a.m. through Friday, January 13 at 7:00 a.m.**

Starting Tuesday night (January 10) crews will work for **three nights** to place the final bridge spans. On each of these three nights **(January 10, 11, and 12) SW Macadam Avenue north of SW Curry Street and the nearby I-5 northbound on-ramp will be CLOSED between 8:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.** Traffic detours are listed below.

Nearby residents in Lair Hill and South Waterfront may experience nighttime noise as the crews bolt the bridge spans together. However, this work will be further way from residences than previous bridge span placements, which should lessen the direct noise and vibrations.

DATES AND TIMES: Tuesday night, January 10 from 8:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.
Wednesday night, January 11 from 8:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.
Thursday night, January 12 from 8:00 p.m. to 5:00 a.m.

DETOUR ROUTES:

SW Macadam Avenue northbound will be closed at SW Curry Street. This will affect motorists traveling northbound on SW Macadam Avenue, as well as motorists leaving I-5 North at Exit 299A (*Oregon 43/Hwy 26/Ross Island Bridge/Macadam Ave*).

Motorists will turn right onto SW Curry Avenue and follow a signed detour along SW Moody Avenue, SW River Parkway, and SW Harbor Drive to reach SW Naito Parkway and downtown Portland.

- **To access I-5 South**, motorists will turn left from SW River Parkway onto SW Harbor Drive to reach the I-5 on-ramp.
- **To access I-5 North**, motorists will follow a signed detour to the Morrison Bridge and the I-5 on-ramp.
- **To access US 26 East and the Ross Island Bridge**, motorists will travel south on SW Naito Parkway and follow the signs to the Ross Island Bridge and US 26.
- **To access US 26 West**, motorists will travel west on SW Clay Street and follow the signs to US 26.
- **To access Oregon 43 South**, motorists will travel south on SW Naito Parkway and follow the signs to Oregon 43 and Lake Oswego.
